Join us on June 19! Let your individual and collective voices be heard.

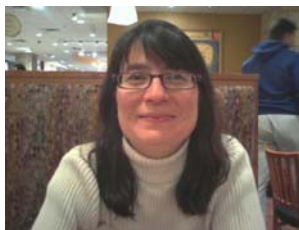
